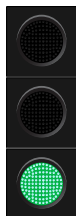


Warning Signals for Blood Clot (DVT/Deep Vein Thrombosis)

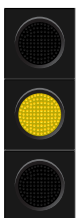
Green Light - Good Signs - All is Well!



- ✓ Affected area is cool to the touch and without pain, swelling or discoloration

Yellow Light - Caution Signs - Time to Act!

Call your doctor if you have:



- ✓ Swelling in the affected area
- ✓ Pain, tenderness in the affected area (may feel like cramping)
- ✓ Warmth, redness or discoloration of the affected area
- ✓ Heaviness in the limb, particularly when standing
- ✓ Leg fatigue

Red Light - DANGER Signs - STOP!



- ✓ Sudden coughing (possibly with blood)
- ✓ Sharp, stabbing chest pain
- ✓ Unexplained sudden onset of shortness of breath
- ✓ Severe lightheadedness or fainting
